If the PRP Board decides to initiate a formal ad hoc review, then, after notifying the Regulator, the PRP will publicise the fact that an ad hoc review is to take place, including the criterion or criteria that have triggered the review. The formal ad hoc review process also allows us to gather information from the public.

We are however not yet at that stage. The processes before that stage are not public processes and therefore the PRP Boards consideration will be in the confidential session of the October meeting.
