

Dear Press Recognition Panel

I am a member of the public, a supporter of the Royal Charter, and have a longstanding interest in ensuring that the Leveson Report is delivered fully and effectively. I have considered the consultation and read Hacked Off's submission to the PRP consultation. I am writing firstly to say that I back Hacked Off's submission prepared with the input of victims of press abuse. I hope you will take note of this.

I have often been appalled by the behaviour of journalists, the poor standard of reporting, the "witch hunts", the intrusive use of photography, and the minimal space given to apologies or corrections when these have been required: so much so that I no longer purchase a daily paper, but I still maintain a great interest in what I feel is essential, a press regulator with the power to investigate fully and impose appropriate and proportionate sanctions.
