Dear Sir or Madam

Leveson suspected the press would refuse to establish a system of independent self-regulation that met his criteria. Since that is what is happening, the Government must not block the law passed by Parliament in 2013 that would guarantee access to justice for victims of libel and press intrusion. It was designed by Leveson to encourage the big newspapers to join a properly recognised self-regulator.

The Press Recognition Panel (PRP) must surely conclude that most significant publishers remain outside a recognised system and must therefore conclude that the big newspapers have rejected and sought to undermine a Leveson compliant system.
