

I would urge you to remind Parliament what the Leveson Report said should happen if the industry tried to veto his recommendations and refused to comply which is what appears may happen. Regardless of whether IMPRESS is recognised by the Press Recognition Panel, the Panel should strongly recommend to Parliament that the key guaranteed access to justice incentive (section 40 of the Crime and Courts Act) should be brought into effect as Parliament had intended. Anything short of that would mean that the whole process has been of total waste of time and money.
