

Dear Panel members,

Lord Justice Leveson's inquiry was very thorough, unbiased and its finding acknowledged by Parliament when it passed a law to guarantee access to justice for victims of libel and press intrusion. It would seem that the press have circumnavigated, with skill, Lord Leveson's intentions and recommendation for an independent regulator of the press. I therefore urge you, before making your report to Parliament, to read again Leveson's conclusion and request Parliament to implement a law to ensure that the press cannot go on saying boo to it.
