

May I remind your organisation of the Leveson Report recommendation should the Press industry try to veto the Report's recommendations, and refused to comply:

"Government should be ready to consider the need for a statutory backstop regulator being established to ensure, at the least, that the press are subject to regulation that would require the fullest compliance with the criminal and civil law,"

and that you,

recommend to Parliament that the key 'guaranteed access to justice incentive (section 40 of the Crime and Courts Act) should be brought into effect as Parliament intended.

As the organisation responsible for ensuring that the UK Press observes a suitable respect for the public, and the Law.
