

Re the PRP report to Parliament.

I am deeply concerned that the self-regulation of the press will not meet the recommendations of the Leveson report. Either due to a number of significant publishers remaining outside a regulatory system or the lack of a regulator.

If this is the case I believe it is essential that parliament is reminded of the Leveson report conclusion that the government consider statutory regulation in order to ensure at the least fullest compliance with the law.

In addition I urge the PRP to recommend to parliament that section 40 (guaranteed access to justice incentive) be brought into effect as parliament intended.
