

It is very important that effective press regulation is implemented in the UK, and much of our press has shown itself adept at wriggling out of efforts to reform the system, often spuriously citing press freedom.

This is your opportunity to ensure that Leveson is not buried, as previous reports have been. In particular 'guaranteed access to justice incentive' (section 40 of the Crime and Courts Act) should be supported.
