I note that the as yet unofficial supervisory body, Impress is not acknowledged by a very large section of the national press.

I would therefore hope that you can only conclude that the conditions that the Leveson Inquiry set out as a minimum for the continued self-regulation of the press have not and cannot be achieved by this means.

I therefore urge you to now move on to Leveson's next and inevitable conclusion that statutory, external supervision will have to be imposed. Please will you now expedite this process with all due alacrity.
