

There are publishers and others in the industry who intend not to follow the Levenson proposals. Levenson foresaw this eventuality and made it clear that in such a case the govt must intervene. All must be fully subject to civil and criminal law and the govt has a responsibility to see that this happens. Further, 'section 40' should be initiated immediately to protect the individual from prohibitive court costs as well as the industry from legal costs from rich litigants who choose to ignore arbitration.

Too much that is good about Levenson looks like being lost because of government inaction and delay. The PRP should urge the govt and parliament to implement section 40 immediately.
