

To whom it may concern:

As you know, the Government is stalling on ratifying the 2013 act which was supposed to satisfy some of Leveson's recommendations---a pretty flagrant violation of the will of Parliament. The current situation of the lack of an independent press regulator is clearly a disregard of Leveson's recommendations.

Can you please make sure that your report details the press's failure to meet Leveson's recommendations of a voluntary body satisfying his specifications, and that Leveson's explicit recommendation was that in this case there is a need for a statutory backstop regulator.

It is particularly important that whatever you report, it includes the provision of legal representation for those suffering unjustly at the hands of the British Press.
