

It is now clear that the press industry has unsurprisingly vetoed the Leveson recommendations and refused to comply. I would, therefore, urge the PRP to remind the Government that it should very seriously consider the need for 'a statutory backstop regulator to be established to ensure that 'the press are subject to regulation that would require the fullest compliance with the criminal and civil law.' Furthermore the PRP should very strongly recommend to Parliament that

Section 40 of the Crime and courts Act should be brought into effect as Parliament had intended.
