It appears that the British Press Industry, since 2012, is not to be trusted and is incapable and unwilling to regulate itself.

Leveson stipulated that should the Press try to avoid and veto his recommendations, there should be an independent regulator established to ensure that the press is subject to criminal and civil law.

Also, the implementation of a law passed in 2013, which would give access to justice for those victims of press abuse and libel, appears to now being blocked by Parliament.
